

Blue Boar MEGA TCT Hole Cutters Speed Settings

Always follow the safety instructions provided by the manufacturer with your power drill.

Optimum cutting performance at 1000 RPM. Use slower speed range if drill has 2-speed gearbox.

****IMPORTANT ****

DO NOT USE WITH STUD DRILL such as Milwaukee Hole Hawg. This will cause the carbide tips to be ripped off during use.

NAILS in WOOD – Avoid whenever possible, as they may cause the carbide tips to be ripped off . If a nail is hit while boring a hole in wood or other materials, the best tactic is to use the drill on its “SCREW DRIVING” setting. The clutch will slip as the hole cutter gradually cuts through the nail and this will minimize backlash and make the drill easier to control.



WARNING Always wear eye protection that complies with current ANSI Standard Z87.1.2. Always disconnect power to tool before removing the hole cutter to prevent tool from starting. Before using, read and understand power tool owner's manual observing all safety rules and instructions.
